Planning for Drought

- Have a plan in place
- Have someone to hold you accountable
- Keep a list of potential culls
- Look at Rainfall
- Estimate Forage Bank
- Have a date to cull cows by if need be
- Early wean if necessary
- Leave as much residual as possible
